The Italian designers' "Bye Bye Wind Table" provides a practical answer to this problem. What's more, four large container spaces at the corners are great for placing serving bowls or potted herbs ready to be snipped and sprinkled. They have even thought of moulded chairs with back pockets to pair with the square console.
